Peabody, in partnership with London Square, has announced the first public consultation on the future of Holloway Prison.

This will give attendees the chance to:

- Work from a blank map of the site
- See the constraints of the site
- Prioritise the future uses of Holloway Prison
- Leave feedback

There will also be an opportunity to view the Islington Museum's *Echoes of Holloway Prison* exhibition, kindly on-loan from their St John Street home.

UPDATE

On March 8th, 2019, Peabody announced the acquisition of Holloway Prison from the Ministry of Justice, enabled by the Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan's, Mayor's Land Fund.

Phil Church, from Peabody's development team said "Peabody are bringing development plans forward in partnership with London Square, with both parties committed to an inclusive and wide-reaching community engagement programme. So far, we have written to nearly 10,000 local residents, over 50 community groups, and hosted over 100 people on tours of the prison. We're looking forward to carrying on the discussions and hearing people's views and ideas."

EVENT DETAILS

The consultation will be held at the Holloway Prison Visitors' Centre, accessed via Parkhurst Road opposite the Exan Garage, it is fully wheelchair accessible. Hoardings will soon be going up around the site behind the treeline. This is purely for security reasons, and no works on the prison are taking place.
